SHELTERS, GROUP HOMES & TRANSITIONAL FACILITIES

Agencies are authorized to weatherize shelters for the homeless, group homes or homes providing transitional living if the buildings are owned or rented by a not-for-profit agency and are used exclusively to provide temporary living quarters for homeless, battered women, or other program-eligible persons as defined under 10 CFR Part 440.3, and as long as each dwelling unit is EmPOWER eligible and meets the following prescribed building and income eligibility requirements:

- Annual usage in the facility must be in excess of 10,000 kWh.
- The resident's income may not exceed 200% of poverty.
- Current utility rate must include the EmPOWER surcharge and be residentially metered.
- A whole-house audit is performed which results in all measures having an overall SIR of at least 1:1.1.
- The building is considered to be a single family structure or eligible multi-unit structure.

Documentation verifying that the unit meets the above criteria must be included in the Hancock system when an invoice is submitted for payment.
