




DHCD FY 2016 FUNDING SUMMARY

In fiscal year 2016, a total of \$2,216.8 million funded various housing and community development programs in Maryland.

- Direct financial resources of DHCD were \$1,440.8 million or 65.0% percent of all resources.
 - Bond funds totaled 32.6 percent or \$722.7 million the largest source
 - Federal funds totaled \$580.8 million or 26.2 percent -2^{nd} largest source
 - State Funds (general/special funds, tax credits, general obligation bonds) amounted to \$137.4 million or 6.2 percent of the resources.
 - Direct funds leveraged an additional \$776.0 million in private funds, representing the remaining 35.0 percent of all financial resources.
 - Every dollar of direct DHCD resources generated an additional \$0.54 in leveraged funds.
 - DHCD programs assisted 50,829 Maryland families with affordable homeownership/rentals and foreclosure prevention counseling

DHCD PROGRAM FUNDING SOURCES FY 2016




DHCD FY 2016 ECONOMIC IMPACT ANALYSIS

DHCD financial activities in FY 2016 generated \$3,129.3 million in total expenditures that produced the following economic impact for the state of Maryland:

- Generated \$698.1 million in wages and salaries
- Produced and an estimated 19,315 full-time equivalent jobs
- Created \$80.7 million in selected State and local tax revenues
- Every one million dollars of DHCD State funds generated a total of 141 full-time equivalent jobs across all DHCD programs
- Every dollar of DHCD State funds leveraged \$5.6 in direct investment and \$22.8 in total economic impact statewide




DHCD FY 2016 SOCIAL IMPACT ANALYSIS


DHCD's investments are allocated within these five major programs generating the following social impacts:

- Assisted 10,398 Maryland families with homeownership and housing rehabilitation needs
- Created 4,674 new and rehabilitated affordable rental housing units
- Helped 31,376 Maryland residents with rental subsidies
- Funded 537 projects across Maryland to help improve the quality of life in local neighborhoods
- Served 495 communities to enhance neighborhood resources
- Assisted 468 businesses with funds to support economic growth
- Provided counseling services to close almost 10,000 Maryland homeowners facing foreclosure through the Department's HOPE initiative.

DHCD INVESTMENTS BY JURISDICTION FY 2016

DHCD investments are allocated by jurisdiction across Maryland with average expenditure of \$1,028 per household in FY 2016.

- Investment per household was below \$300 in Cecil County;
- Ranged between \$300 and \$500 in Baltimore, Calvert, Carroll, Queen Anne's and St. Mary's counties;
- Between \$500 to \$1,000 in Anne Arundel, Harford, Howard, Montgomery, Talbot and Washington counties;
- Exceeded \$1,000 in Allegany, Baltimore City, Caroline, Charles, Dorchester, Frederick, Garrett, Kent, Prince George's, Somerset, Wicomico and Worcester counties.
