

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FORECLOSURE HOT SPOTS


A foreclosure *bot spot* is defined as a community that had more than 10 foreclosure events in the given quarter and recorded a foreclosure concentration ratio of greater than 100. The concentration ratio, in turn, is measured by a foreclosure index. The index measures the extent to which a community's foreclosure rate exceeds or falls short of the state average foreclosure rate.

For example, the Hamilton community in Baltimore City (zip code 21214) recorded a total of 11 foreclosure events in the second quarter, resulting in a foreclosure rate of 537 homeowner households per foreclosure and a corresponding foreclosure index of 194. As a result, the foreclosure concentration in Hamilton is 94 percent above the state average index of 100.

Overall, a total of 663 foreclosure events—accounting for 46.2 percent of all foreclosures in the second quarter—occurred in 37 hot spot communities across Maryland.

These communities recorded an average foreclosure rate of 486 homeowner households per foreclosure and an average foreclosure index of 215. Hot spots communities are further grouped into three broad categories: "high," "very high," and "severe" (Chart 1).

FORECLOSURE HOT SPOTS CATEGORIES


- *High* foreclosure communities post foreclosure indices that fall between 100 and 200. There were 231 high foreclosure events recorded across 15 communities, representing 40.5 percent of foreclosures across all hot spots and 2.9 percent of foreclosures statewide (Table 1, Chart 2). These communities had an average foreclosure rate of 685 and an average foreclosure index of 152.
- The *very high* group includes jurisdictions that post foreclosure indices between 200 and 300. Locations with a very high foreclosure recorded 291 events in 15 communities, representing 40.5 percent of foreclosures across all hot spots and 2.9 percent of foreclosures statewide (Table 1, Chart 2). These communities had an average foreclosure rate of 427 and an average foreclosure index of 244.
- The *severe* foreclosure group consists of communities with foreclosure indices above 300. Seven severe foreclosure communities recorded 141 foreclosure events, representing, 18.9 percent of foreclosures across all hot spots and 1.3 percent of foreclosures in Maryland. (Table 1, Chart 2). Severe foreclosures had an average rate of 281 and an average index of 372.



SEVERE FORECLOSURE HOT SPOTS

The severe group includes jurisdictions that posted foreclosure indices above 300. Three jurisdictions with severe foreclosure notices recorded 141 events in seven communities, representing 18.9 percent of foreclosures across all hot spots and 1.3 percent of foreclosures statewide. These communities had an average foreclosure rate of 281 and an average foreclosure index of 372 (Table 3).

SECOND QUARTER 2022



VERY HIGH FORECLOSURE HOT SPOTS

The very high group includes jurisdictions that posted foreclosure indices between 200 and 300. Four jurisdictions with very high foreclosure notices recorded 291 events in 15 communities, representing 40.5 percent of foreclosures across all hot spots and 2.9 percent of foreclosures statewide. This community had an average foreclosure rate of 427 and an average foreclosure index of 244 (Table 3).




CHART 4B. PROPERTY FORECLOSURES IN VERY HIGH HOT SPOTS COMMUNITIES PART 2



HIGH FORECLOSURE HOT SPOTS

The high group includes jurisdictions that posted foreclosure indices between 100 and 200. 6 jurisdictions with high foreclosure notices recorded 231 events in 15 communities, representing 40.5 percent of foreclosures across all hot spots and 2.9 percent of foreclosures statewide. These communities had an average foreclosure rate of 685 and an average foreclosure index of 152 (Table 3).

SECOND QUARTER 2022




CHART 5B. PROPERTY FORECLOSURES IN HIGH HOT SPOTS COMMUNITIES PART 2

SECOND OUARTER 2022


